## **Our commitment to you**

We are committed to protecting the privacy and security of your personal data. This information sheet, alongside our full Privacy Notice, explains how we do this.



# What is personal data?

Personal data is any kind of information that you can be



identified by, for example, your name, date of birth, address, health records, photographs, etc.




# What information we collect

We collect personal data such as

your name, date of birth, education history, ethnicity, etc. A full list of the data we collect is available in our Privacy Notice. We only collect personal data that we need to provide you with education and related services.

# Why do we collect this information?

We collect this data in order to provide our services, for equal opportunities monitoring,



complying with health and safety law, to assist with queries and for research and planning purposes. Our main lawful basis for these activities is that it is necessary for the performance of a task (providing education), which is carried out in the public interest. We also collect this information in line with our legal and contractual obligations.

# **Sharing your personal** information

To provide you with our services we sometimes need to share your data with third parties, such as technology providers, awarding bodies or the

#### How long we take care of your information?
